## ***DEAC Announces 91<sup>st</sup> Annual Business Meeting***

The *Bylaws* state that the Corporation shall meet annually to elect Directors from its membership, to receive annual committee reports, and to transact other business. The Annual Business Meeting is open to all members.

### **Board of Director Elections to Commence at Annual Business Meeting**

Electronic ballots will be available to all DEAC members beginning April 24, 2017 at the Annual Business Meeting. Each DEAC-accredited institution represented at the Business Meeting is entitled to one vote. Attending the Annual Business Meeting and participating in the election is a concrete way institutions can participate in the continuity or orderly succession of DEAC's leadership and uphold a practice of good governance. ### **Call for Nominations for the DEAC Nominating Committee**

Participating on the Nominating Committee is a meaningful way to engage with the Directors on future leadership needs for DEAC.
