

## **Report from the Accrediting Commission**

**July 28, 2017**

In accordance with its procedure for Notification and Information Sharing (Section X. G), Part II Processes and Procedures, DEAC Accreditation Handbook) and 34 Code of Federal Regulations §602.26(e)(2), the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC) provides written notice to the U.S. Secretary of Education, the appropriate state licensing or authorizing agencies, the appropriate accrediting organizations, and the public if an accredited institution lets its accreditation or preaccreditation lapse within 30 days of the date on which accreditation or preaccreditation lapses.

### **Lapse of Accreditation**

The following institution has elected not to pursue its application for reaccreditation and its accreditation accordingly lapsed as of July 25, 2017. The institution allowed its accreditation to lapse while it was operating under a Show Cause Order.
