Today, the National Advisory Committee on Institutional Quality and Integrity (NACIQI) voted unanimously to recommend DEAC receive five years of recognition from the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Education. This is consistent with the recommendation by the Department of Education staff that DEAC receive five years of recognition.
