

Report from the Accrediting Commission

March 30, 2018

In accordance with its procedure for Notification and Information Sharing (Section X.F.&G.), Part II Processes and Procedures, DEAC Accreditation Handbook) and 34 Code of Federal Regulations §602.26(e)(1), the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC) provides written notice to the U.S. Secretary of Education, the appropriate state licensing or authorizing agencies, the appropriate accrediting organizations, and the public if an accredited institution decides to resign or voluntarily withdraw from accreditation or elects not to renew its accreditation.

The following institution has elected to voluntarily withdraw from accreditation, effective March 21, 2018. DEAC is providing this notice in addition to complying with the accreditation online collection system.
