

## **Distance Education Accrediting Commission**

### **Public Notice: Show Cause Directive**

**May 13, 2021**

The DEAC Accrediting Commission will provide written notice to the U.S. Secretary of Education, the appropriate state licensing or authorizing agencies and accrediting agencies at the same time it notifies the institution of the decision to deny accreditation. In addition, DEAC will provide written notice to the public on its website of the decision within 24 hours of the decision and provide a brief statement summarizing the reasons for the decision. (Section XV., Processes and Procedures, *DEAC Accreditation Handbook*). At its May 12, 2021 meeting, the Commission voted to direct the following institution to show cause why accreditation should not be withdrawn:

The reason for the Commission's decision is set forth below.

#### **Section XVII.A, Part Two, Process and Procedures, *DEAC Accreditation Handbook***

An institution maintains its accreditation status by remaining in continuous compliance with all DEAC accreditation standards and eligibility requirements; all applicable local, state, and federal requirements; timely fulfillment of all payment obligations to DEAC and timely submission of reports, including the Annual Report. As of the date of this public notice, NLRO has not met the requirement that it submit the Annual Report in accordance with formats and timelines published by DEAC (Section XVII.A, Part Two, Process and Procedures, *DEAC Accreditation Handbook*).
